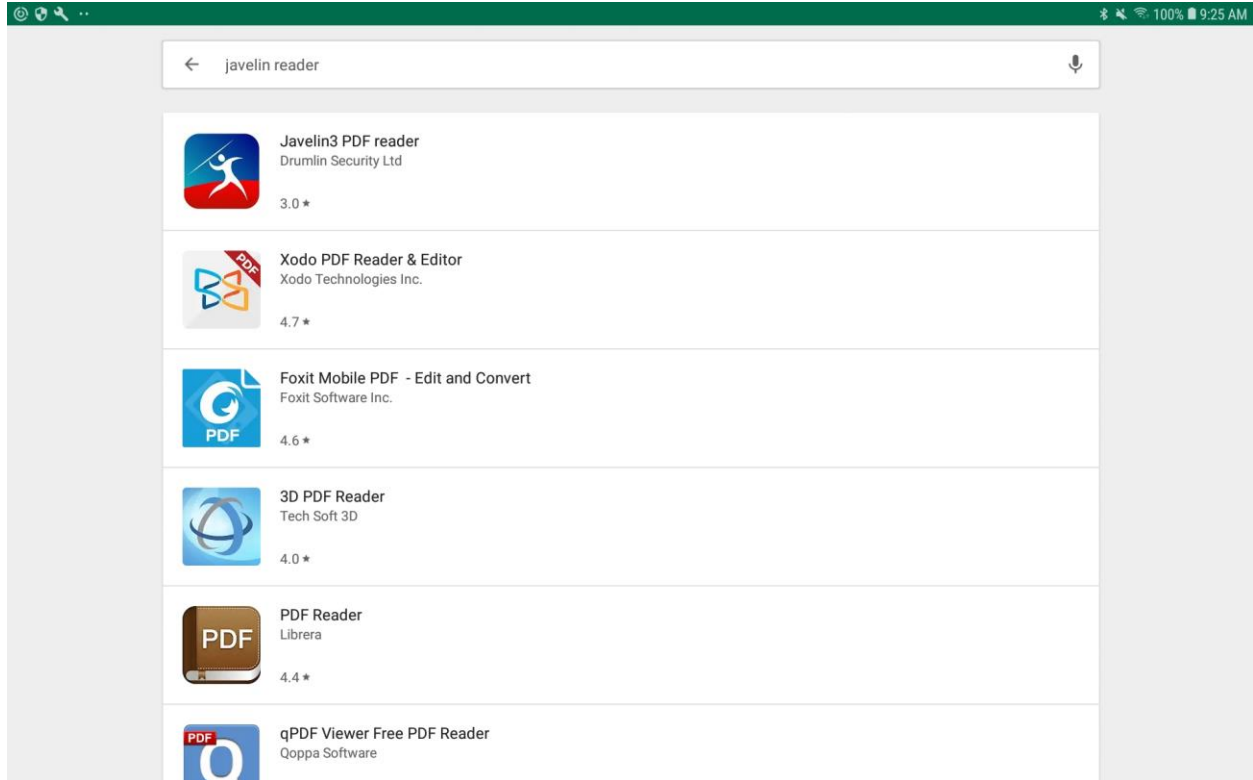


Detailed download instructions for Android devices

Please follow these instructions carefully!

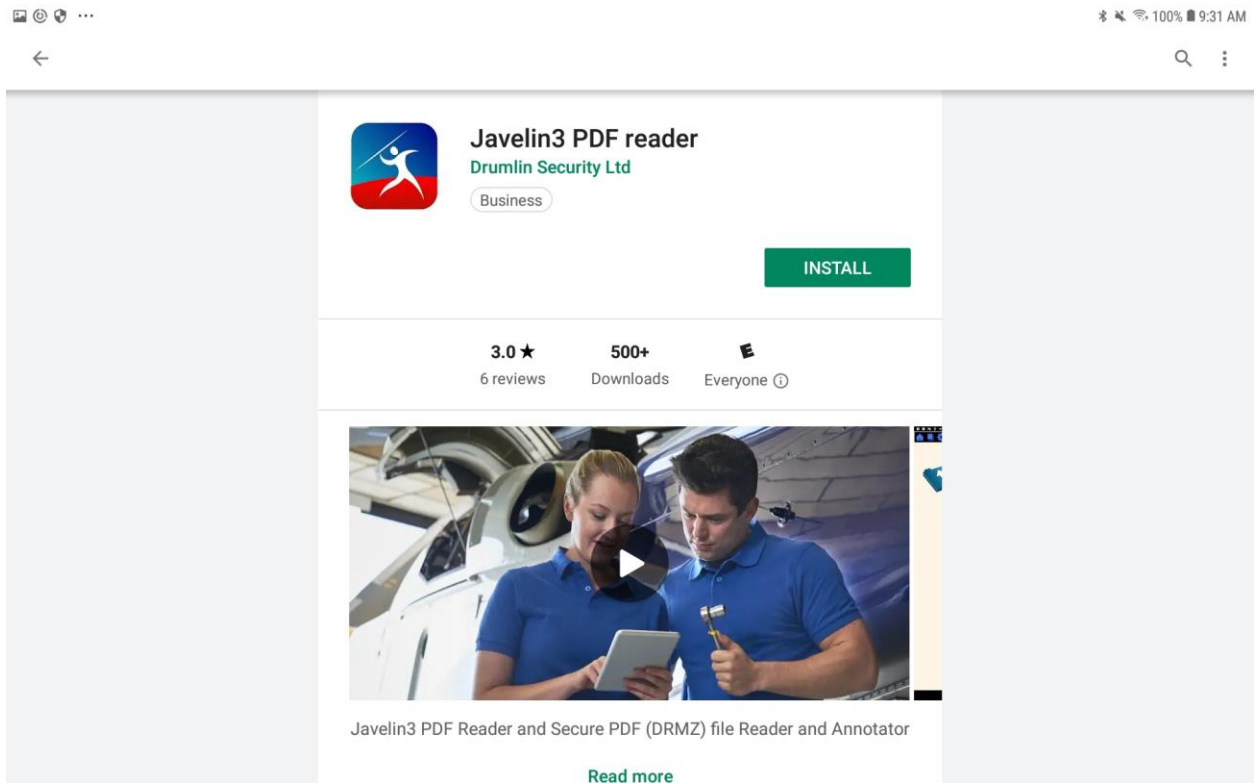
STEP 1 – Search for the Javelin3 reader on the Google Play Store

Go to the Google Play store and search for **Javelin reader**. Tap on **Javelin3 PDF reader**.



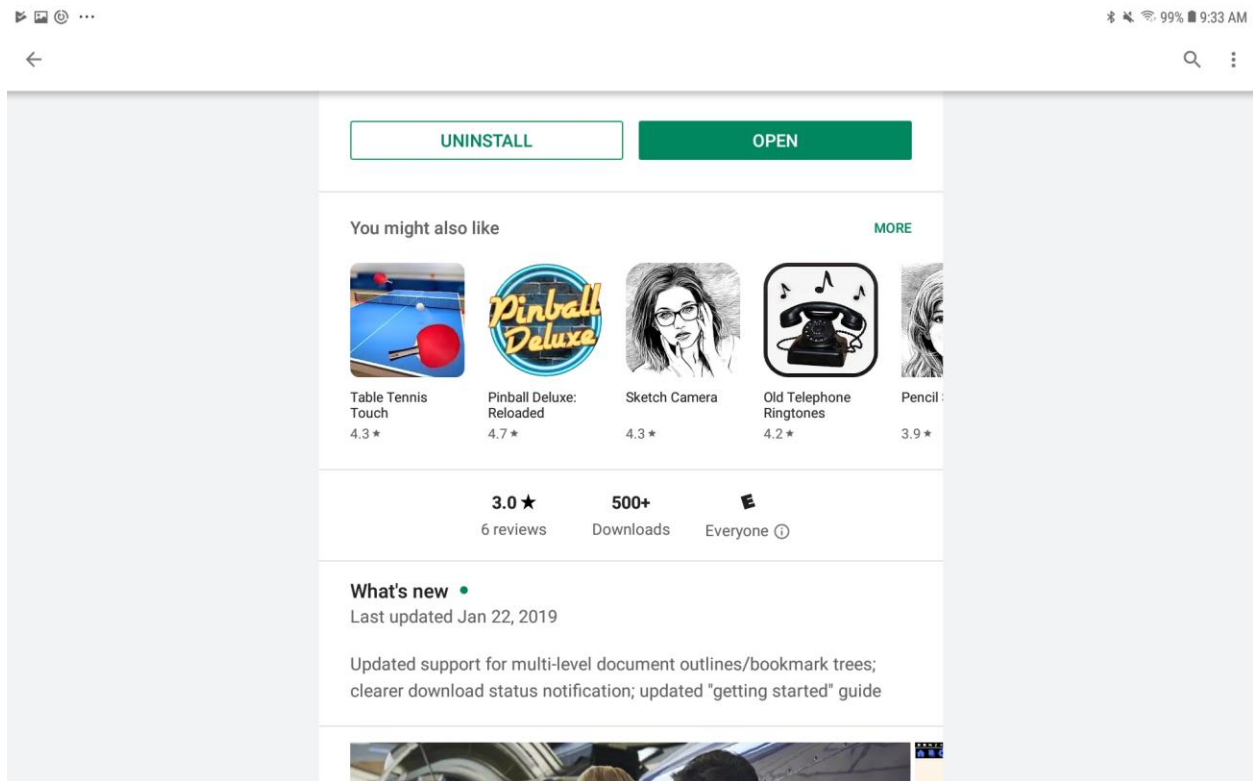
STEP 2 – Install the Javelin3 reader

Tap on **INSTALL**.



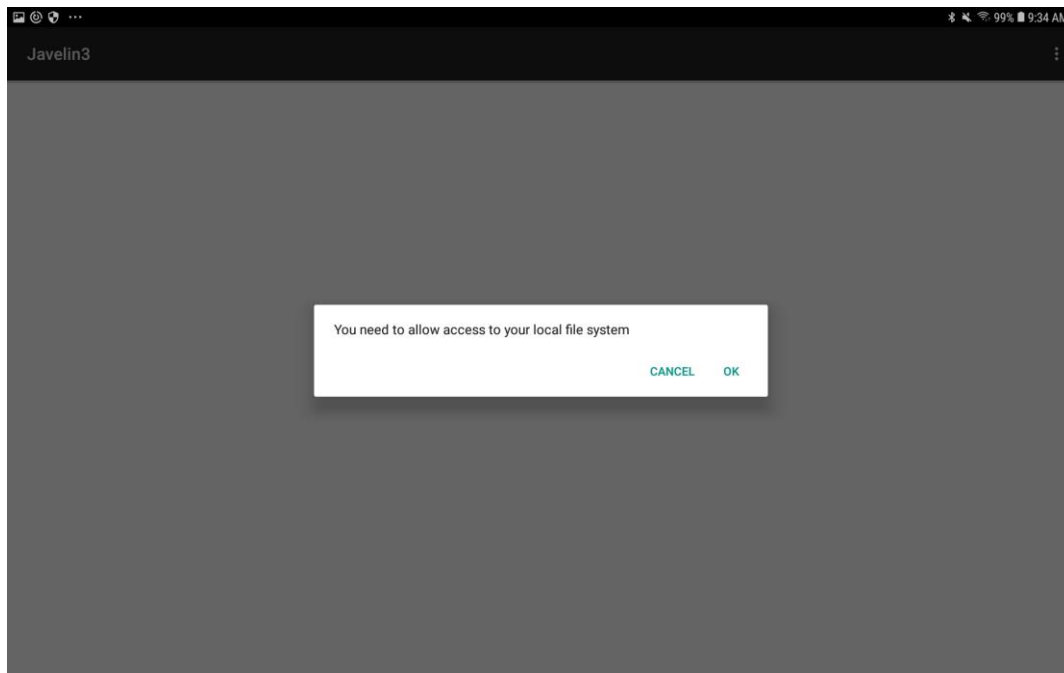
STEP 3 – Open the Javelin reader

Once reader has downloaded tap on **OPEN**.

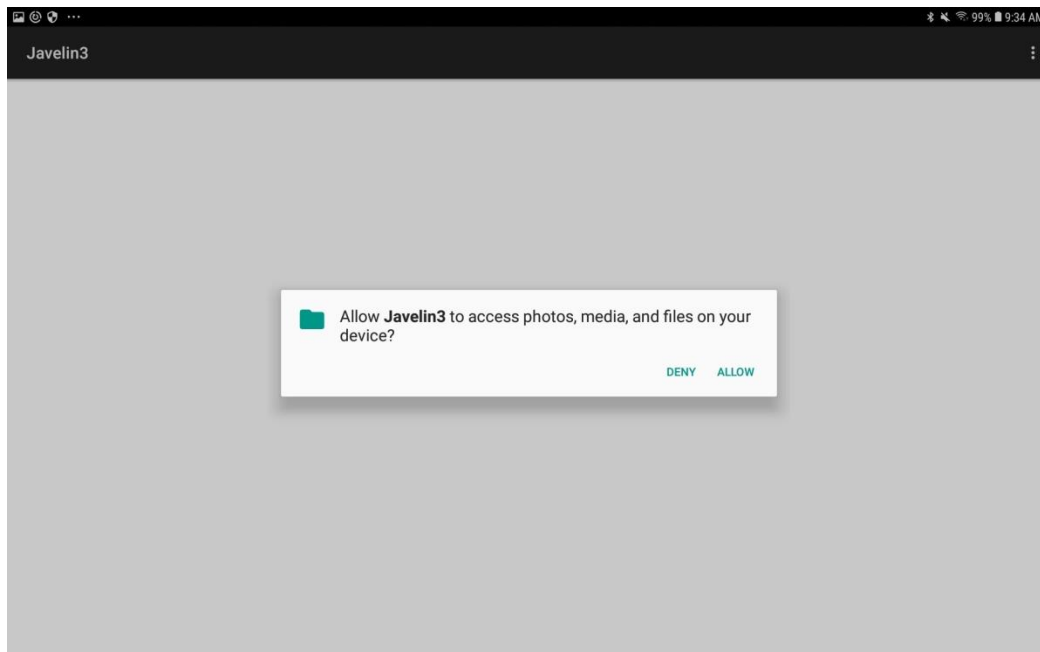


STEP 4 – Grant the Javelin reader access to your local file system

You may need to grant access to the Javelin reader – if so, tap on **OK**.

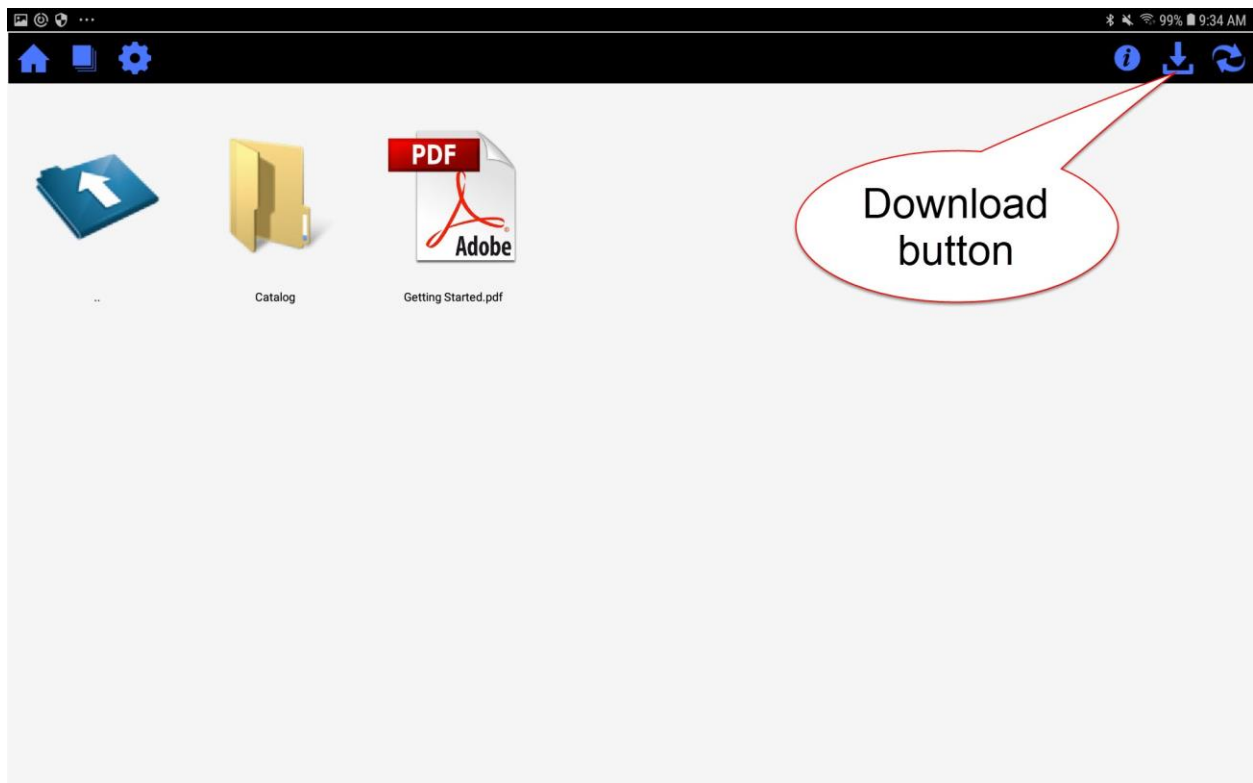


Tap **Allow** to grant access to photos, media and files on your device.



STEP 5 – Download the Pilot Weather secure Digital Rights Management (drmz) file

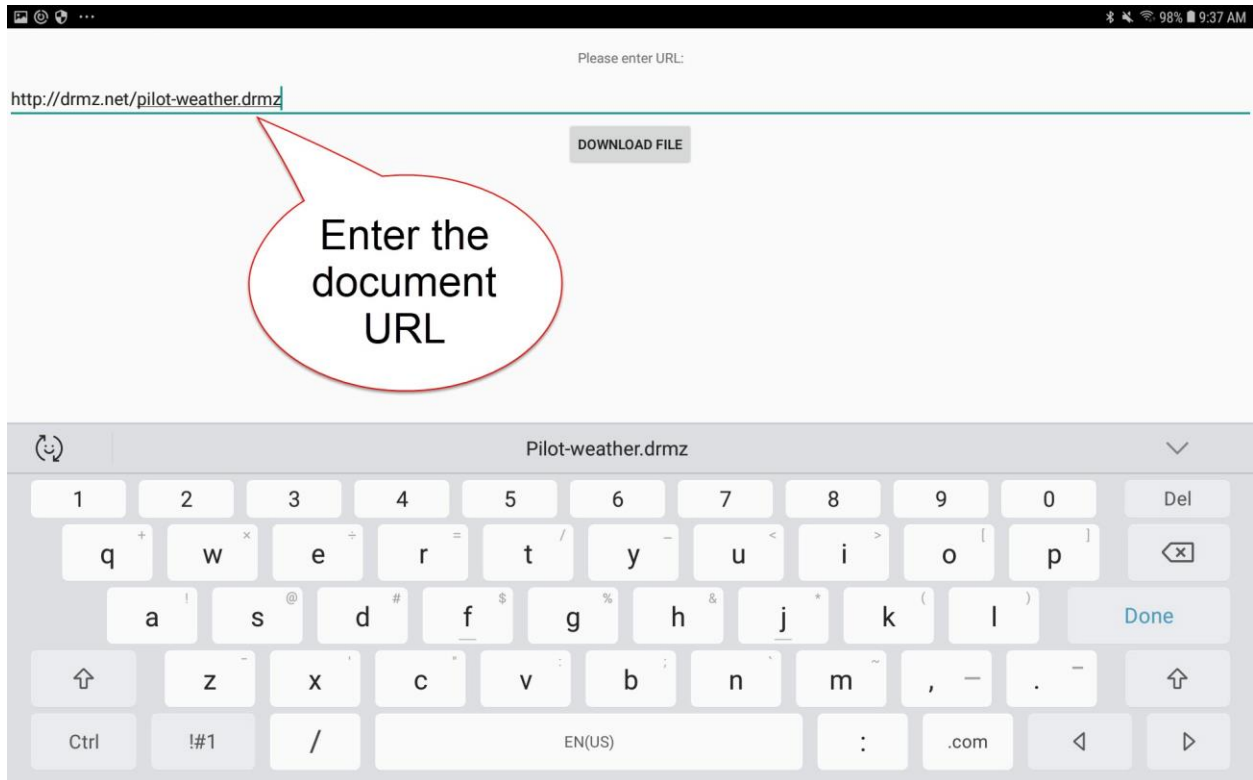
Once the reader has opened click on the Download icon – see picture below.



STEP 6 – Download the Pilot Weather secure Digital Rights Management (drmz) file

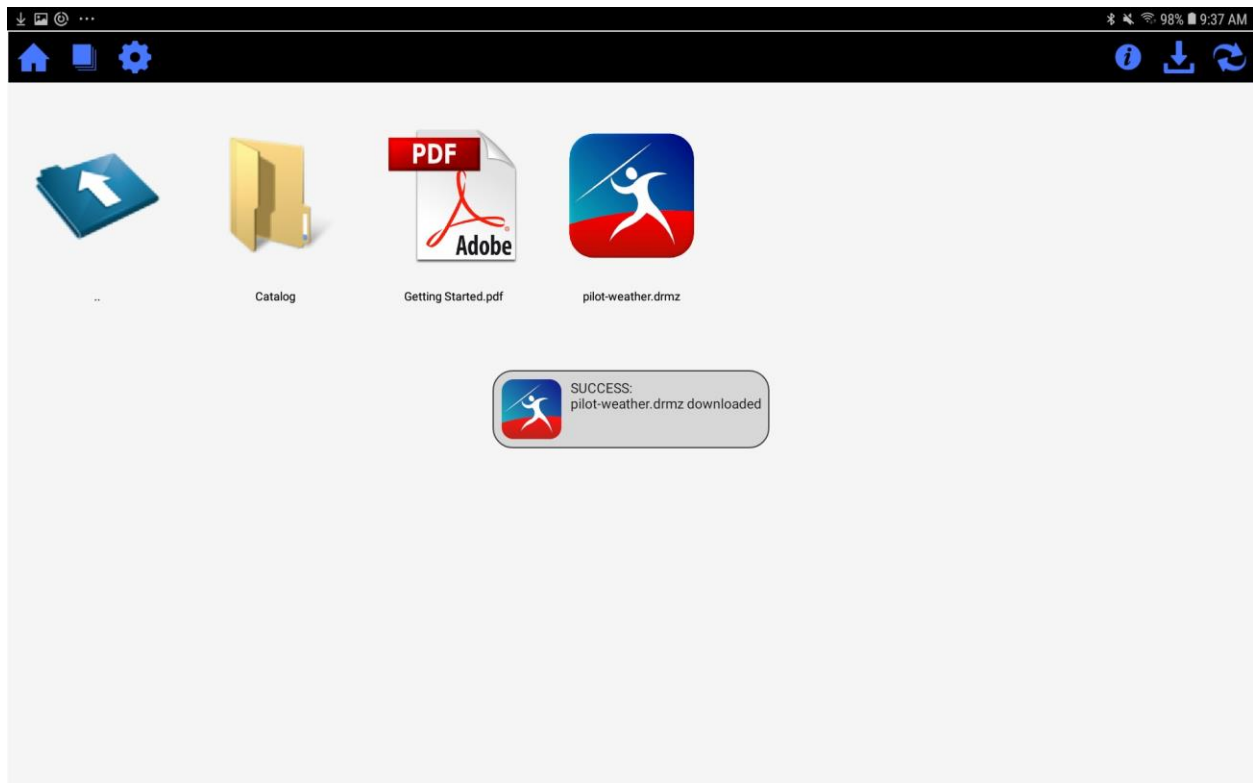
You are almost done! Type (or copy and paste) the following e-book URL:

<http://drmz.net/pilot-weather.drmz> into the window as shown below, then tap on **DOWNLOAD FILE**.



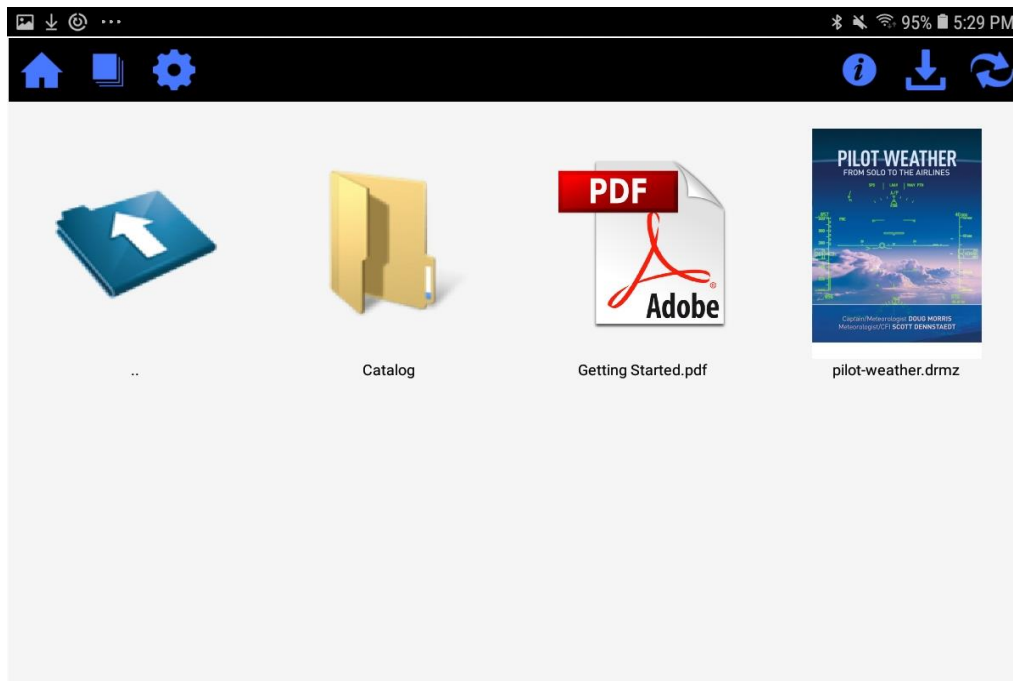
STEP 7 – Download complete

A **SUCCESS** message will appear when the download has completed successfully.



STEP 8 – Open the secure Pilot Weather drmz file

Tap on the Pilot Weather e-book icon labeled **pilot-weather.drmz**



STEP 9 – Enter the unique authorization code

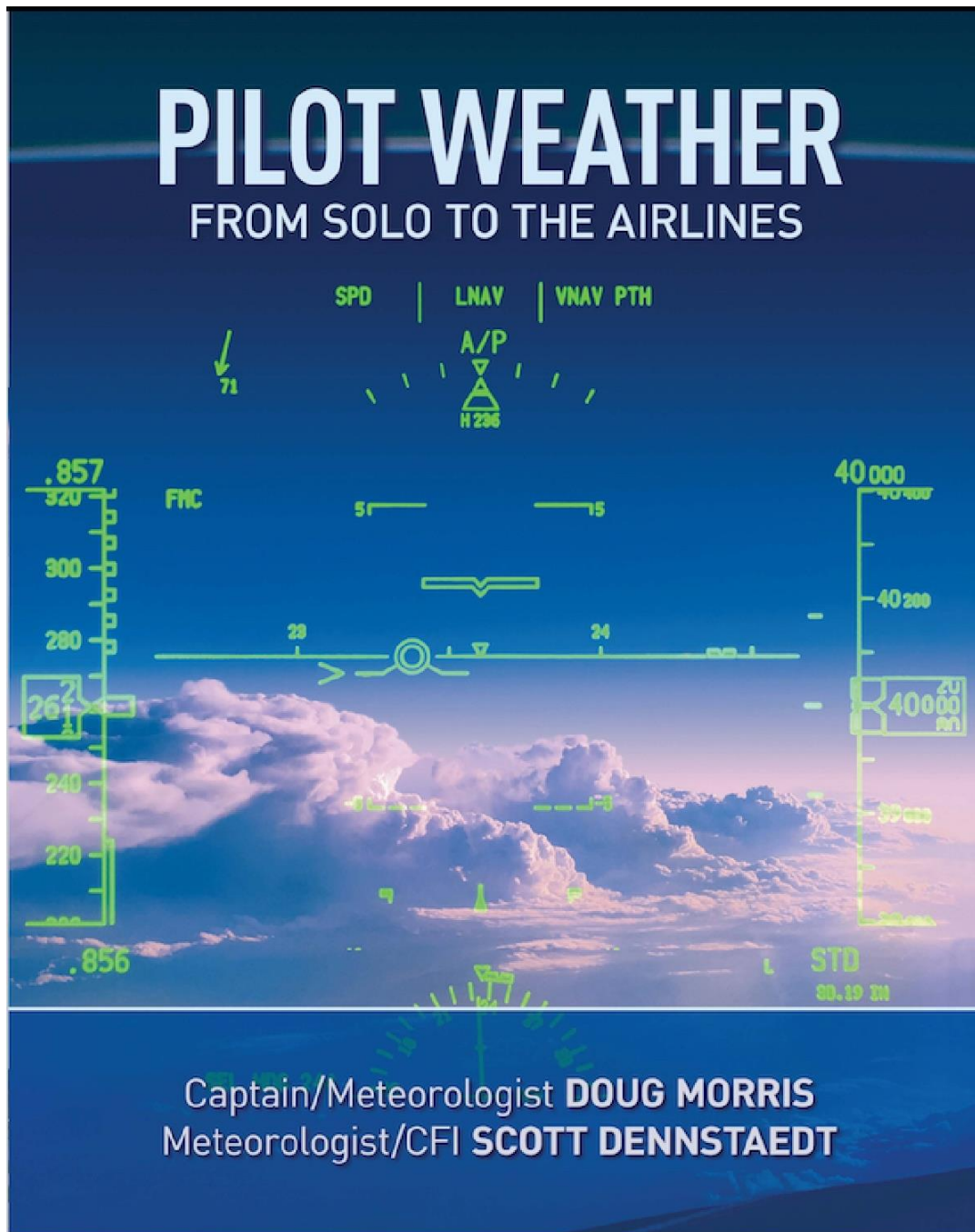
Enter the authorization code sent to you in your confirmation email and tap on **AUTHORIZE**.

This code is unique to you and your copy of the e-book. You will be allowed to repeat this process on up to four (4) additional devices using the same code (e.g., laptop/computer, tablet and smart phone). Please note that the **DocID** shown in the image below may be different than shown on your screen. This DocID is **NOT** your authorization code.

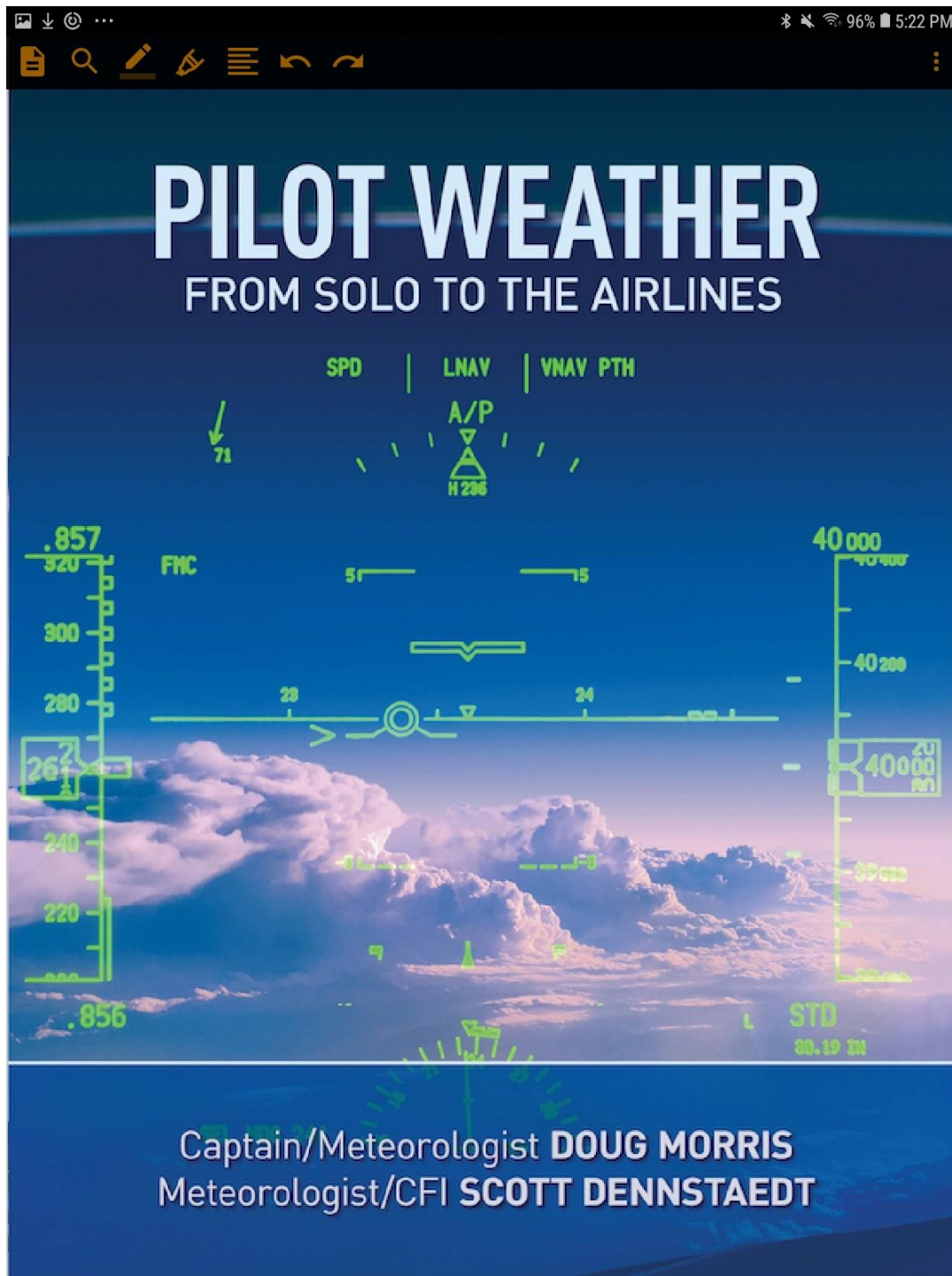
STEP 10 – You are ready to begin reading the Pilot Weather e-book

You are all set. Happy reading! See below for a few additional notes.

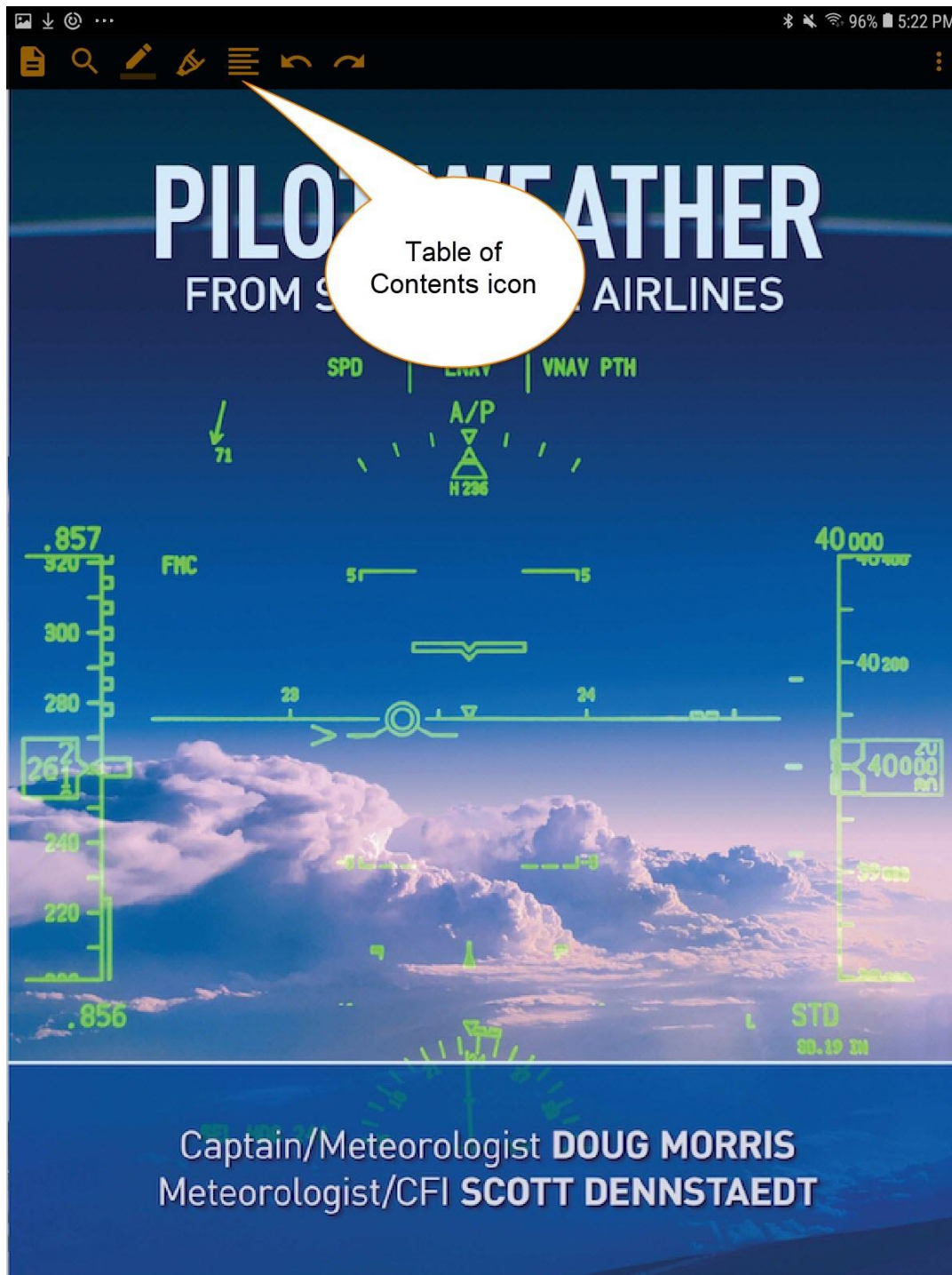


SIDE NOTES

1a. To view the **Table of Contents**, first tap the center of the screen to expose the Javelin tool bar.
